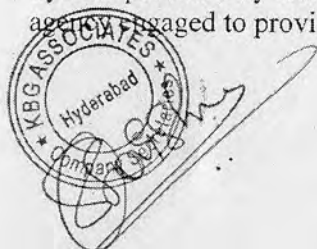

Sub: Consolidated Scrutinizers Report on remote e-voting pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule made there under and e-voting during the AGM pursuant to MCA General circular number 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021 read with 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020

- 1) The Board of Directors of the Company, vide Resolution dated August 13, 2021, had, pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of Companies (Management and Administration) Rules 2014, appointed me as Scrutinizer for the remote e-voting process as well as e-voting facility during the 15th Annual General Meeting (AGM), in relation to matters set out in the Notice convening AGM of the Company held on Monday, September 27, 2021, at 10.00 AM through Video Conferencing (VC) / Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM).
- 2) The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules relating to voting through electronic means by the Members on Resolutions contained in the Notice of the AGM of the Company.
- 3) My responsibility as a Scrutinizer is to ensure that the voting process both through remote e-voting and e-voting during the AGM are conducted in a fair and transparent manner and render consolidated Scrutinizer Report of the total votes cast in favour or against, if any, to the Chairman on the Resolutions passed, based on reports generated from the e-voting System provided by Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL"), the authorized agent engaged to provide e-voting facilities at the AGM.



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- 4) Pursuant to Regulation 44(1) and (2) of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure requirements regulations, 2015 and as prescribed under Rule 20 (4) (xiii) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015 for the purpose of ensuring that Members who have cast their votes through remote e-voting do not vote again at the Annual General Meeting, the scrutinizer shall have to access after closure of period of remote e-voting and before the start of Annual General Meeting, to only such details relating to Members who have cast their votes through remote e-voting, such as their names, DP ID and Client ID / Folios numbers of shares held, but not the manner they have voted. Accordingly, CDSL, the remote e-voting agency provided us with the names, DP ID and Client ID / Folios numbers and shareholding of the Members who had cast their votes through remote e-voting.
- 5) The Company has provided the facility of e-voting during the AGM to the Members who attended the AGM and had not casted their votes through remote e-voting facility.
- 6) The Company has informed that, on the basis of the Register of Members, and the List of Beneficial Owners made available by the depository viz., National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), the Company completed dispatch of the Notice of the 15th AGM on September 03, 2021, to Members who had registered their e-mail addresses with the Company / Depositories.
- 7) Further to the above, I Submit my report as under:
 - a) The Company has appointed Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) as the agency for providing e-voting platform.
 - b) In accordance with the notice of 15th Annual General Meeting sent to the shareholders and the "Advertisement" published pursuant to Rule 20 (4) (v) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as modified from time to time, the remote e-voting period remained open from 9:00 A.M. on Friday, September 24, 2021 and ended on Sunday, September 26, 2021, at 5.00 P.M. and the Members were required to cast their votes electronically conveying their assent or dissent in respect of the Resolutions, on the remote e-voting platform provided by CDSL.
 - c) The Members of the Company as on the "cut-off" date i.e. September 20, 2021, were entitled to vote on the Resolutions (Item No.1 to Item 5 as set out in Notice of AGM of the Company).
 - d) The votes were reconciled with the records maintained by the Company (Investors Service Cell) and CDSL with respect to authorization.
 - e) The votes on remote e-voting were unblocked at around 01-18 P.M., after the conclusion of voting at the AGM on Monday, September 27, 2021, in the presence of two witnesses Ms. Shilpa Sirasanagandla and Ms. Saroja Boosarapu who are not in the employment of Company and the e-voting results / list of equity shareholders who have voted for and against were downloaded from the e-voting website of

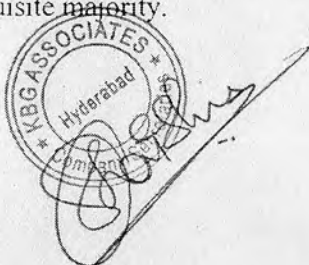
